High School Transition Committee

The Transition Committee continues to meet regularly and is narrowing down the boundary options. Meeting data, maps, and notes can be found [here](#) on the school district website. The group is hoping to have a boundary recommendation to the School Board sometime in January.

A sub-committee has been formed to create a draft of the transfer policy. This policy will go before the full Transition Committee and ultimately, the School Board.

Building Design and Equipment

High School #2

We've been working hard on the FFE (furniture, fixtures, and equipment) lists. These will start going out for bids after the break. Construction continues to make visible progress as walls and roofs are constructed daily. The three-story classroom building is nearly enclosed and interior wiring work is progressing. The two-story CTE wing's exterior walls are going up as well as interior hallways, locker rooms, and the weight room in the athletic wing. Take a drive down Flander's Mill to see the progress.

BHS Renovation

The warm, dry weather has been conducive for earth moving as the stadium project continues. As soil is moved out, gravel will be moved in to create drainage for the turf field. The main classroom building renovation will not begin until spring/summer 2020. However, additional site work may be completed in the next 18 months. The first draft of design plans should go before the School Board in January.

Staffing Information

Many departments are already beginning to proactively plan to mix up teaching assignments next school year to allow teachers to collaborate while everyone is still in the same building. High School Programming Committee

The updated diploma as well as the distinction options was approved at the December School Board meeting. These changes will go into effect with next year's incoming freshman class. However, the special circumstances option will be available beginning this year. This should only be considered in extremely rare circumstances and students can only be referred by a counselor.

Activities and Athletics

MHSA policies are being considered by the Transfer policy sub-committee and as soon as we have a school name we can finalize the MHSA "intent to join".

We're also gathering information as part of the FFE process. Additionally, we are in the very early stages of discussing fundraising and boosters and what that looks like for two schools.
